Award, National Youth Award, etc.

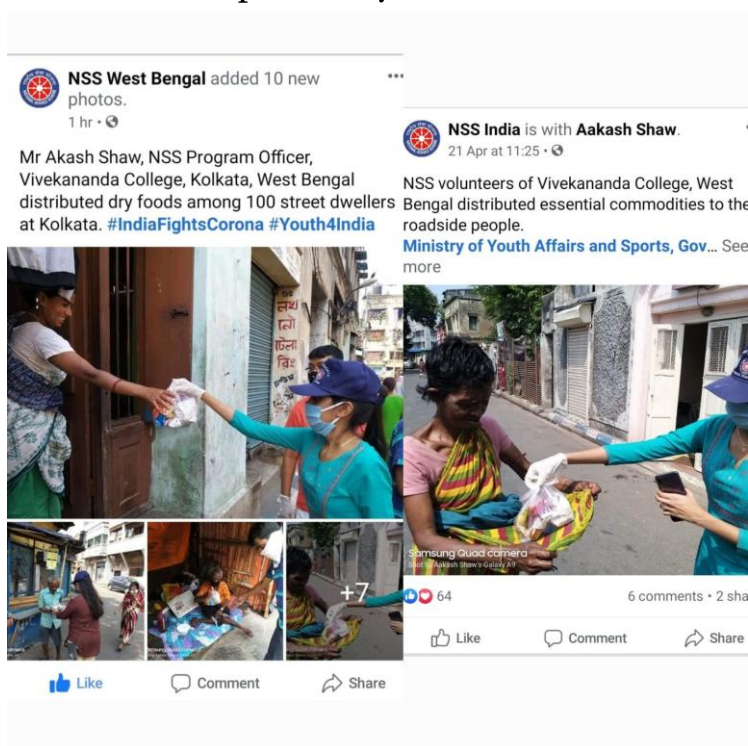
