#### Departmental meeting for selection of Add-On Course and Course Coordinator

A departmental meeting was held on **15.5.2018** to consider the following:

- 1. Implementation of the Add-On courses as per IQAC recommendations.
- 2. Classes of 1- or 2-hours duration adding up to 30 hours per course, to be conducted in blended mode for students under CBCS system.
- 3. To fix course coordinators and other modalities for a smooth implementation of the courses.

#### Resolutions

- 1. As per the recommendation of IQAC and Principal's notification dated **10.5.2018**, the department will offer Add-On courses to all Honours and General students of B.SC, from the academic session 2018-2019. The course will be conducted in the blended mode.
- 2. It was unanimously decided that the Honours and general students will be offered a 30 hours Add-On course from November, 2018. The departmental teachers unanimously resolved to offer Add-On course to English Honours students on **Gender Values -I for Sem I(H)** and **Gender Values -II for Sem III(H)**. The choice of this "cross-cutting" issue is made not only because of its relevance and urgency at present but also because English Literature Studies has always found itself dealing with Gender and Racial issues within the syllabus.

# Communicative Writing Skills – For B.SC General students

**Written communication** is the exchange of information, ideas, or messages through written language in the form of letters, emails, notes, and much more. Written Communication involves expressing with clarity; using language with precision; constructing a logical argument; note taking, editing, summarizing; and writing reports.

Although the core course prescribed by UGC and University of Calcutta addresses these issues, more emphasis and precision is required to achieve the desired goal.

# Course Objective – Communicative Writing Skills

- 1. To train students in most effective written communication that is useful in the daily life and offices
- 2. To train students to write correctly and effectively.
- 3. To teach students the three main elements of effective written communication:
- Structure the way the content is laid out.
- ➤ Style the way it is written.
- Content what one is writing about.
- 4. Structure and layout can be learnt quickly but learning how to write good quality content takes much longer. Hence, emphasis on Clarity of thought, Identification of key points, stress on logical thinking and order.

- 5. To train students to write summaries, synopsis, precis in order to facilitate clarity of thought and logic.
- 6. To train them in the basics of office requirements such as letter writing, writing resume and updating them, electronic mails, writing notes, noting proceedings of meetings,
- 7. To train students in order to raise their employability standards, thus ensuring a bright career in any field/discipline.

#### **Course Outcome**

- 1. Effective communication both verbal and written is an asset for all. Communicative Writing Skills increases the employability quotient, by providing young adults an extra edge over the less proficient.
- 2. A thorough training in effective writing will hone flexibility, influencing power, negotiation skills.
- 3. Effective communicative writing leads to analytical and problem-solving skills, which are great qualities to acquire in any discipline and/or career.
- 4. The employable student in any discipline is bound to succeed in their target/objective once they are equipped with the armour of writing skill.
