Departmental Activity:

To increase mathematical potentiality and the sense of healthy competition among the mathematics honours students, the Department of Mathematics organised a quiz competition on April 17, 2019 based on their syllabus. The programme was conducted by all the faculty members of the department. This competition involved 44 students, who were divided into 11 groups of four each. In the quiz, there were four rounds, namely the elimination round, the rapid fire round, the visual round, and the final round. Students enjoyed the programme with positive responses.

4. The Department of Mathematics also organised an educational visit at the 45th International Kolkata Book Fair on March 12, 2022. Our excursion to the book fair had the aim of introducing students to a wide variety of books and cultivating a passion for reading in a variety of different categories. Twenty-five students and three faculty members visited this book fair. We all enjoyed the fair and selected the books we wished to read. The college provided 10,000 rupees, and the students brought various mathematical books that are stored in our college library.

In memory of "Srinivasa Ramanujan," our department organised a lecture competition on "Jounney Through Ramanujan's Works" in collaboration with the Department of Mathematics, Vivekananda College for women on December 20, 2023, at Vivekananda College, Thakurpukur. The aim of a lecture competition on Ramanujan, the renowned Indian mathematician, is to promote awareness, appreciation, and a deeper understanding of his life, work, and contributions to the field of mathematics. Students from two colleges have participated. The winner's position was selected by two external judges.
